(from 2014 Comp Plan) Bowdoinham has no sewers. In 2011, the Bowdoinham Water District has 252 connections in Bowdoinham. Most are residential customers (about 21% of the Town's households are connected). Twelve are commercial customers. Five are municipal accounts (Town of Bowdoinham). The Bowdoinham Community School is connected. There are 46 fire hydrants in Bowdoinham. The Town of Bowdoin has 23 connections and 8 hydrants.
