This season, we can look forward to some exciting developments. The Merrymeeting Arts Center is hoping to install some of Bryce Muir’s whimsical outdoor sculptures which will enliven the area. The Aging Committee is also talking about rating the trails for accessibility and may have recommendations for future improvements.
