Making Conservation Work for You

What Can We Do to Help?

Androscoggin Valley Soil and Water Conservation District offers fee-for-service technical assistance. District staff are available to assist landowners in Androscoggin and Sagadahoc counties address conservation concerns. Services are provided at a fee of \$60/hour. The first site visit is complimentary. Usually at least three hours are required for service, depending on the request.

Planting Designs and Revegetation Plans

If you're working on a construction project, we can create revegetation plans that comply with local zoning and State Shoreland Zoning guidelines. We can also create scaled site plans, plant lists, and written recommendations for ecologically-sound landscape designs, like rain gardens or pollinator gardens.

Erosion Assessment

Having problems with erosion on your site? Staff can help identify how erosion is affecting your property, both for shorefront and other properties. Common problems include private gravel roads and driveways.

Conservation Landscape Certification Program Assistance

Ready to certify your backyard as a wildlife-friendly, soil and water-improving landscape? We can walk through the Conservation Landscape Certification checklist in-person on your site and make suggestions for implementing conservation practices in a systematic way.

GIS Mapping

District staff can produce 'existing condition' maps of private properties or generate other maps using publicly available data, as needed.
