Definitions:

Open Space: Open space is defined as “Undeveloped or minimally developed land and water areas, public or private, that have special value to the community in the areas of natural habitat, water resources, scenic or cultural resources, recreational resources and working lands. Open space can include forests, fields, wetlands, bodies of water, as well as farmland, and working forests. Open space can be minimally improved land such as a park, ballfield, or recreational trail, as well as public access to such improvements.
