To help protect open spaces, the Comprehensive Planning Committee (CPC) will be working over the next 2-3 years on creating an Open Space Plan through writing, research, and public outreach. What is a Comprehensive Plan?

- A long-term vision for the town, laying out goals and ideas for the next 10 years.
- Guides growth, protects town character, and supports grant applications.
- Adopted in 2024, we're now working on its goals—starting with an Open Space Plan to preserve public areas.

What is an Open Space Plan & why write one?

- It is a strategic document that guides the conservation and management of natural areas, parks, and undeveloped land to improve quality of life and environmental sustainability.
- The purpose in writing one is to be proactive in protecting important natural resources, support recreation, strengthen community connections, and guide responsible development.
- Where are we at? The planning process is just getting started; we aim to gather data, engage the public, and develop strategies for protecting and enhancing Bowdoinham's open spaces.

What does our Tree Sub-Committee do?

- Charged with drafting a Tree Care policy with recommendations for municipal tree maintenance, including pest control, removal, and replacement for Selectboard approval.
- Provides public education through seminars and informational materials in collaboration with forestry experts.

- Once approved, get sworn in by the Town Clerk.
