(Before assuming the duties of office, a Town Official shall be sworn by the moderator in an Open Town Meeting, by the Clerk, or by any other person authorized by law to administer an oath Unless the oath is administered in the presence of the Clerk, the person who administers it shall give the official a sworn certificate which shall be returned to the Clerk for filing. Title 30-A M.R.S.A., §2526(9).)

Caution: A person must make a separate oath for each office to which he or she is elected. For example, a person elected to serve as both selectperson and assessor should be sworn separately to each office.
