

Subject: Thank You for Helping Shape Bowdoinham's Pavilion

Dear Pavilion Stakeholders,

Thank you for participating in recent meetings and conversations to help shape the vision for a new pavilion at Bowdoinham Riverfront Park. Your feedback from farmers, artisans, nonprofits, families, and other community members played a key role in defining how this space can best serve Bowdoinham.

Based on this input, the Community Development Advisory Committee recommended a flexible, accessible, and environmentally responsible pavilion. The proposed three-season, open-air timber frame structure is designed to support markets, events, classes, performances, and everyday park use, with an emphasis on functionality, affordability, and long-term adaptability.

What happens next

The Selectboard has placed a warrant article before voters to fund the pavilion through a Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) grant, using previously approved TIF and Rideout Family Trust funds as the required match. If approved, the Town can move forward with final design and construction planning.

The LWCF package also includes other park improvements, such as a new restroom, a natural play area, and parking and access improvements at Maily Waterfront Park. Additional details are included in the attached factsheet.
