# Outreach Coordinator



Age Friendly Bowdoinham is seeking a part-time Outreach Coordinator as part of its participation in a statewide pilot program. The goal of the Neighbor to Neighbor project is to support older adults reduce social isolation and access essential services. This is a volunteer position for which the selected individual will receive a stipend from the UMaine Center on Aging for a 12-month commitment.

The Outreach Coordinator will recruit and train local volunteers to meet directly with Bowdoinham residents to better understand their needs and preferences and to improve access to services necessary for health and wellbeing.

The successful candidate for the Outreach Coordinator should be a resident of Bowdoinham, ideally with experience in grassroots community work and volunteer-led initiatives. The individual must demonstrate the ability to work in a collaborative setting, have knowledge of resource challenges of older adults, have effective interpersonal skills in working with diverse organizations and individuals, and strong oral and written communication skills.
