

Abagadasset River View Information Sheet

There is no street address for this location, but it is easy to find and marked by a small dirt lot and a gate at the entry point to the old landfill on Carding Machine Road. The land starts around a mile to 1.5 miles south of the bridge over the Abagadasset. There is a large gate blocking a pathway out to the public land that goes past the old landfill.

Hours: None – Always Open to The Public

Parking: Parking can be found along Carding Machine Rd. and there is a small lot in front of the entry gate.

Activities: Spring/Summer/Fall - Bird Watching, Walking, and Fishing
Winter – Snowshoeing

Directions From Public Library

(If Travelling by GPS Use This Street Address, Then See Instructions: 500 Carding Machine Rd, Bowdoinham ME, 04008)

-Turn **left** onto School St and **right** onto Main St.
-At the stop light turn **left** onto River Rd.
-Turn **left** onto White Rd. and then turn **right** onto Dinsmore Cross Rd.
-Turn **left** onto Carding Machine Rd. and **continue** toward Richmond for just under 2 miles

-**Continue** north on Carding Machine Rd. for 0.5 miles
