

**WARRANT AND NOTICE OF ELECTION CALLING
MAINE CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION REGION 10 REFERENDUM
(20-A M.R.S. §§ 8456 & 1351 to 1354)**

TO: John T. Stivers, Jr., a resident of Maine Career and Technical Education Region 10 ("Region 10"), composed of the Town of Brunswick (Brunswick School Department), the Towns of Durham, Freeport and Pownal (members of Regional School Unit No. 5) and the Towns of Bowdoin, Bowdoinham, Harpswell and Topsham (members of Maine School Administrative District No. 75).

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby ordered to serve upon the municipal clerks of each of the municipalities within Region 10, namely the Towns of Brunswick, Durham, Freeport, Pownal, Bowdoin, Bowdoinham, Harpswell, and Topsham, an attested copy of this warrant and notice of election. The municipal clerks of each of these municipalities shall immediately notify the respective Municipal Officers. The Municipal Officers shall meet forthwith and countersign this warrant and notice of election. The Municipal Officers shall provide below for the respective municipal clerks to post or have posted this warrant and notice of election.

TO: James Magno, Resident of Bowdoinham: You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of this municipality of the election described in this warrant and notice of election.

TO THE VOTERS OF BOWDOINHAM: You are hereby notified that a Region 10 referendum election will be held in the Town of Bowdoinham at Bowdoinham Community School, 23 Cemetery Road, on Tuesday, June 11, 2024, for Bowdoinham voters to vote on the following referendum question:

Question 1: Do you favor authorizing the Cooperative Board of Maine Region 10 Technical High School ("Region 10") to issue bonds and other evidences of indebtedness in the name of Region 10 in an amount not to exceed \$643,821 through the State of Maine's zero interest rate/loan forgiveness School Revolving Renovation Fund (SRRF) Program for the renovation and improvement project that is required to remove and replace the bridge structure at the exterior of the Region 10 school building (the "Project")?

A. Project Explanation: The primary focus of the Project involves removal and replacement of the bridge structure at the exterior of the Region 10 school building, which local officials have determined must be replaced to ensure continued safe access to the building. The Project also involves replacement of the stairs leading to the bridge and other interior and exterior work required to remove and replace the bridge structure and stairs.

B. Financing Explanation: The Project costs up to a maximum of \$643,821 have been approved for funding through Maine's SRRF Program. Of this amount, Region 10 will receive 44.99% (up to \$289,655) that will be forgiven, and 55.01% (up to \$354,166) that Region 10 will repay at zero interest (0%) over a term of ten years.

Voting shall be by secret ballot referendum. The polls will be opened at 8:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.


The registrar of voters shall hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change to a name or address on the voting list, to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
