

Pork Point Walking Trail Information

(There is no street address for this location, but the entrance is marked by a small gravel parking area)

Hours: None – Always Open to The Public

Parking: There is a small gravel lot near the trail head

Activities: Spring/Summer/Fall - Bird Watching, Walking, Canoeing, and Picnicking
Winter – Snowshoeing

Trail along the water can get eroded slightly so mind your step!

Open fires and camping are not permitted at this location.

Directions from the Bowdoinham Public Library

(If Travelling by GPS Use This Street Address, Then See Instructions: 304 Pork Point Rd. Bowdoinham ME, 04008)

- Turn **left** onto School St and right onto Main St.
- At the stop light turn **left** onto River Rd.
- Turn **right** onto Browns Point Rd.
- Turn **left** onto Pork Point Rd.

(GPS – Instructions Pick Up Here)

On the righthand side, just past 304 Pork Point Rd (a white farm with a red roof that will be on your left), there is a small parking area.

The location is marked by a yellow gate; you may park here and continue on foot! If the lot is full please park safely on the side of the road.
