Re: Mooring Applications

Enclosed is the 2014 mooring application. Please make any changes to your address, emergency contact info, vessel description, registration #, etc. ALL INFORMATION must be completed before your application will be approved. Return completed applications with fee to the town office. A separate check for this fee is appreciated.

Reminders:

- Please mark your mooring floats with your mooring # in min. of three inch letters.
- Mooring floats need to be WHITE with a blue stripe.
- Skiffs/dinghies tied to the town docks should not exceed 10 feet in length. (canoes/kayaks tend to block access)
- Please mark your dinghy with either your mooring number, name or telephone contact.
- It is recommended that your mooring and tackle should be pulled and inspected every two to three years. Mooring inspection report forms are available at the town office and need to be returned upon completion.

Free Coast Guard Safety Inspections are available either at the boat ramp or at your home. If interested, contact me to set up an appointment. I also have information on safe boating courses being offered in the area.
