


There is a new opportunity
for towns to use solar power
for their electric needs



A Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) is the mechanism for making this possible. The PPA is a partnership of an Energy Company, a town, and third party investors.





A **PPA** allows schools, nonprofits and municipalities to enjoy the same benefits of clean solar power afforded to businesses and homeowners



Why Should Bowdoinham Consider This?

- ❑ The town will save money on its electric bill.
- ❑ The town won't have to raise any money to do the project.
- ❑ We can choose to continue the project for 20 years without any town investment.
- ❑ Using solar power will help our planet.



After 20 years, Bowdoinham owns the solar array. We have 2 choices at that point:



1. We can decommission the panels and go back to another source of energy;
2. We can take ownership, replace aging parts, and get the full savings from owning the array. With some updates and repairs, most solar arrays last up to 40 years.


