Hours: None – Always Open to The Public

Parking: There is street parking at the end of the road and your destination is just a short walk, or bike ride, past the gate. For events the gate is open, but it is typically closed to cars on any given day.

Activities: Spring/Summer/Fall - Bird Watching, Walking, Biking and Picnicking Winter – Snowmobiling, Snowshoeing and Cross-Country Skiing

-Can get muddy after the rain and the long grasses are beautiful, but the perfect environment for ticks. Be mindful of this and be sure to do a tick-check after visiting!

Open fires and camping are not permitted at this location.

Directions From Public Library

**(If Travelling by GPS Use This Street Address, Then See Instructions: Wildes Rd.
Bowdoinham ME, 04008)**

-Turn **left** onto School St and **right** onto Main St.

-At the stop light turn **left** onto River Rd.

-Turn **right** onto Browns Point Rd.

(GPS – Instructions Pick Up Here)

-Turn right onto Wildes Rd and follow the road to the end.

-If the gate is across the road you may park in the sand turn around to your left.

If the gate is up, you may drive down the path until you reach the second parking area. Be mindful however that the road is not maintained regularly and there may be walkers on the road. If you are able, we recommend parking at the gate.
